The MWPA wishes to announce that nominations for the 2024 Volunteer of the Year Award are now open! This award is designed to recognize the contributions and achievements of our incredible volunteers and the unique contributions to improve the water polo community.

Volunteer of the Year Award Criteria

- The Nominee must be a resident of Manitoba and a member of the MWPA in good standing.
- The Nominee must give freely of their time, energy and skills without monetary compensation.
- Demonstration that the nominee shares their time, effort and skills leading to positive impacts.
 Include evidence of the impact and outcome of this contribution e.g. enhancing the enjoyment
 or development of participants, raising the profile of water polo, and/or bringing honour and
 respect to the water polo community. Both short-term and long-term results should be
 considered.
- The nominee has a shown commitment to the development and advancement of water polo.
- Demonstration that the nominee living and delivering MWPA Values.

Nomination Process:

- Nominations are invited from any individual or organization that would like to recognize the impact a volunteer has made on the water polo community.
- Nominations must relate to the 2023/24 Season.
- Provide a high-resolution photograph of the Nominee.
- The Nominee (or their parent/guardian) must consent to the publication of the information within the nomination form as it may be used by the MWPA for promotional purposes.
- The Nominee must not have previously been a MWPA Volunteer of the Year Award recipient.



- All application and all supporting documents are to be sent no later than 4:00 pm on September 23, 2024 to: <a href="mailto:mailt
- Finalists will be notified and invited to attend the AGM on October 6, 2024, at 3:30 pm where the winner will be announced.
- If the nomination does not meet the award criteria it will not be accepted.

Tips

Be clear about why your nominee stands out

This is the perfect time to express what makes your nominee special and how they have gone above and beyond to help their community.

Tell a story!

Set the scene and provide background on your nominee. Using examples will create a picture for the panel and help them understand your nominee's efforts.

What is the impact of your nominee's contribution? Be sure to mention the immediate effects and the wider impact.

The more comprehensive and complete that the nomination information is, the better!

MWPA reserves the right to verify the validity of nominations and disqualify any nomination which, in the opinion of the MWPA, can be considered objectionable, potentially insulting or inflammatory or generally damaging to the goodwill or reputation of the award, or any nomination that is not compliant with the terms and conditions.
